

RFRF Global Privacy Policy for the Economic Outlook Conference attendees.

Introduction

RF ("RF" or "We", "us"), respect your privacy and we are committed to protecting your privacy through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes our practices in connection with information that we collect through the attendance at the RF Economic Outlook conferences and references RF's privacy practices in relation to the use of RF's websites (such as www.rfbeo.com, www.rfceo.ky & www.rfgroup.com/eastern-caribbean-economic-outlook-conference/).

This policy also describes your data protection rights, including a right to object to some of RF's processing. The Policy does not apply to information collected by any third party, including through any third-party application or content (including advertising) that links to or is accessible from our Applications or websites.

RF considers a Conference attendee to be a delegate or a speaker at its Conferences.

What types of personal data do we collect from Conference attendees?

RF collects a variety of personal data from and about the Conference attendees.

Where a Conference attendee is a delegate, information collected includes: name, organization, job title, e-mail address, telephone number, and credit or debit card number.

Where the Conference attendee is a speaker at a conference, information collected includes: name, organization, job title, e-mail address, telephone number, education, interests, experience, career and references to awards or recognition for their work.

How does RF collect personal data?

RF requires that each Conference delegate registers their attendance through the relevant website (www.rfbeo.com or www.rfceo.ky and www.rfgroup.com/eastern-caribbean-economic-outlook-conference/). Registration through these sites asks that Conference delegates voluntarily and explicitly enter personal data.

Information about the Conference speakers is gathered directly from the speaker or their agent and public sources such as the press or the Internet.

How does RF use personal data?

RF stores the personal data volunteered during the registration process and uses this information to:

- To collect payment for attendance at the Conference;
- Send tickets to each Conference attendee;
- Inform the Conference attendees on the conference details; such as speakers, agenda, and conference logistics;
- To introduce the Conference speakers to the Conference delegates; and
- To correspond with each Conference attendee to inform them of other RF products that may be of interest to them.

RF also shares attendee information with:

- The Conference sponsors so that they may correspond with each Conference attendee to inform them of their products that may be of interest to the Conference attendee; and
- The Conference hosts and subcontractors (such as hotels) to ensure that the Conference attendee needs are met.

Does RF use or sell personal data collected about the Conference attendees?

RF does not use personal data of the Conference attendees for any purposes other than stated in the Privacy Notice. RF does not sell personal data of the Conference attendees to any third party.

What is the legal basis for RF to process personal data?

RF's legal basis for collecting and using personal information about the Conference attendees is our legitimate interest and not overridden by the individual's data protection interests, or fundamental rights and freedoms.

These legitimate interests are to:

- Provide attendees with access to the Conference;
- To introduce the Conference speakers at the Conference;
- To send attendees information on the Conference;
- To ensure the security at the Conference by preventing unauthorised access, and
- To enforce compliance with our terms of use, contracts and other policies.

How long does RF store personal data collected about the Conference attendees?

RF may store information about the Conference attendees for up to 7 years after attendance at one of its Conferences.

How can a Conference attendee access, correct or delete their personal data?

Conference attendees have the right to access their personal data and, if necessary, have it amended, deleted or restricted. Conference attendees may also ask for personal data to be delivered to them, or another organization they nominate, in a structured and machine-readable format.

Where RF processes your personal data on the basis of your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Individuals also have the right to complain to the relevant supervisory authority for data protection where they believe that RF has not met its obligations on Data Privacy.

Conference attendees are responsible for complying with any regulations or laws requiring notice, disclosure or obtaining consent prior to transferring the data to RF for processing purposes. Any third party that seeks to access, correct or delete data, should direct their query to the Conference attendee. If the Conference attendee requests RF to remove their personal data to comply with data protection regulations, RF will process this request within 30 days.

We will not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect. In such instances, we will inform the Conference attendee about the legal obligations that prevent us from fulfilling the request.

How can a Conference attendee access, correct, or delete their personal data?

Any Conference attendee that seeks to access, correct or delete data, can do so by submitting a request to the following email address: dataprotection@rfgroup.com.

RF will maintain an audit history of any requests to access, correct or delete personal information to maintain a record of compliance with regulatory requirements.

How does RF use cookies for its Conference website visitors?

RF uses 'cookies' as individuals interact with our Conference websites to collect certain information about their equipment, browsing actions and patterns.

We process website Visitor data separately from Conference attendee data. By visiting our websites Visitors consent to the collection, processing and storage of their personal information as described in the website privacy policies:
